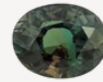

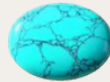

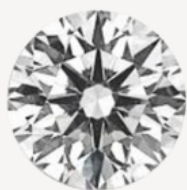

Silver is a natural, white precious metal. However, while it is very affordable, silver is not suited to engagement rings because it is a very soft metal that bends out of shape easily.

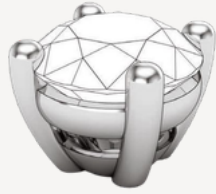
Titanium
